

**GSHP 2000 PREVENTIVE MEDICINE GUIDELINES
SUMMARY CHART OF IMMUNIZATIONS SCHEDULE**

Vaccines are listed under routinely recommended ages. The lightly shaded areas indicate range of recommended ages for immunizations. Any dose not given at the recommended age should be given as a “catch up” immunization at any subsequent visit when indicated and feasible. Varicella Zoster should be offered to any child greater than 12 months of age. The diagonally lined areas indicate vaccines to be given if previously recommended doses were missed or given earlier than the recommended minimum age.
